ALL REGISTRATION WILL TAKE PLACE THE EVINRUDE CENTRE AND ALL TEAMS MUST REGISTER PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST GAME.

REGISTRATION: A total of nineteen (19) players per team may be signed, two of which are registered as goaltenders. **PLEASE COMPLETE AND RETURN TOURNAMENT ROSTER FORM, INCLUDING SIGNATURES AND COMPLETED ENTRY FORM. PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY MUST BE PROVIDED ON ARRIVAL AT TOURNAMENT. PHOTOCOPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

ONLY ORIGINAL PLAYERS CARDS OR O.W.H.A. ROSTER SHEETS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

If teams do not have original players certificates or stamped roster sheets for registration at the time of the tournament, THEY MAY NOT BE PERMITTED TO PLAY. The Coach and Trainer **MUST HAVE APPROVED CERTIFICATES.**

Affiliated players (A/P) must be registered with the team and listed on an O.W.H.A. approved A/P list. These players' names should be submitted with the Team List on the Entry Form and marked A/P and appropriate carding submitted. A player may only play for one team during the tournament.

GENERAL INFORMATION: A Peterborough Committee member will be delegated to act as a chaperone for each visiting team, upon request.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries, to make decisions regarding interpretations of Tournament Rules and Regulations, to make decisions regarding objections or protests involving any conduct of the Tournament, and as such, all decisions will be final.

Rules similar to those used in Olympic Hockey will be used to determine standings in the event of a tie in round robin play. Tournament operated under Tournament/OMHA/CHA Sanctions and Regulations.

ALL GAMES WILL BE STOP TIME CONSISTING OF 2- TEN MINUTE AND 1-FIFTEEN MINUTE PERIODS

All players must wear approved throat protectors as per CHA Rules.

All players must wear an intra-oral mouth guard.

OHF Policy 12: At the Novice and Atom levels both genders may dress in the same dressing room at the same time with the presence of two adults/staff. From the PeeWee level and up players of mixed gender may not dress in the same room at the same time, and it is the responsibility of the Coaches that all players are included in the Pre and Post game activities.

TOURNAMENT PLAYING RULES

All O.M.H.A rules governing hockey shall apply, with the following additions:

17. Any player receiving a major penalty for fighting will be automatically suspended from the tournament.
18. Any player receiving a gross misconduct penalty or a match penalty is automatically suspended from the tournament.
19. Any team official receiving a penalty for fighting will be automatically suspended from the tournament.
20. The referees are sole judges of all goals.
21. All games will be 2 -ten minute and 1-fifteen minute stop time periods. There will be no overtime played until after the completion of the round robin format. **NO TIME-OUTS.**
22. All overtime will be ten minute sudden death. periods
23. Each team must have a certified coach and trainer.
24. Any team official receiving a gross misconduct or game misconduct penalty will automatically be suspended from the tournament.
25. All other matters will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee and their decision will be final.
26. A player will be allowed to play for one team only during the tournament.
27. Before the start of each game, two minutes will be put on the time clock and the clock will start running when the Zamboni has left the ice. When the clock reaches zero, the game will begin.
28. Scheduled game times are approximate. Your team must be ready to play, fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled game time. Extra time is built into the schedule so you must be ready to play fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
29. No one, other than players, coaches and trainers are allowed in the dressing rooms before and after games. A maximum of four coaches and one trainer are permitted.

Method to be used in declaring standings and winners:

30. **GROUP STANDINGS IN ROUND ROBIN PLAY:**

- 30. Each group will play a point series: 2 for a win, 1 for a tie.
- 31. If two or more teams are tied in points, whichever team won the game played against the team which it is tied, places higher.
- 32. If two or more teams are still tied in points, the team with the fewest goals against places higher.
- 33. If two or more teams are still tied, all the goals scored against a tied team are divided into all the goals scored by that team. Team with the greatest quotient places higher.

NOTE: Team with zero goals against will have a divider of one (1).

- 34. If two or more teams are still tied, whichever team scored the first goal in the game against the team which it is tied, places higher.
- 35. If two or more teams are still tied, the tournament committee shall determine the standings by ordering a play-off.

NOTE: When three (3) or more teams are tied in points at the completion of Round Robin Play, once the highest position of the teams is determined, the Tournament Committee shall revert back to rule No. 1 to determine the next best team.

B. IN SELECTING WILD CARD TEAMS overall, the above rules No. 1, 3, 4 and 6 will apply.

C. Rule No. 6 B PLAY-OFF SCHEDULE: if two (2) or more teams are tied, the Tournament Committee shall arrange a play-off schedule. Games will consist of one 10 minute stop time period. If still tied, sudden death overtime will be played until a winner is determined.

31. **TIE GAMES:** In the event overtime becomes necessary to declare winner, sudden death overtime will be played until a winner is declared.
